- No copyrighted materials are allowed in this video and if there are copyrighted material, the video will be disqualified. All images that are used in the video need to be attributed.
- This competition is open to all school learners from grades R-12 based in South Africa.
- All works submitted for this competition must be learners' original works.
- Any scientific facts or statistics used in the video need to be accurate and attributed correctly.
- Entries will be judged in the primary school and high school categories
- The entry forms need to be signed off by a parent/guardian.
- · Videos containing offensive or discriminatory content will be disqualified
- All entries for this competition will be displayed and showcased at the All Atlantic Ocean Research and Innovation Alliance (AAORIA) meeting (21 and 22 November 2023).
